Granisetron Patches



### Product Name

Generic name: Granisetron Transdermal Patches

### Ingredient

The main ingredient of this product is granisetron.

### Description

This product is a colourless and translucent rounded rectangular patch, storing in a sealed bag. The adhesive surface of the patch is covered with a transparent rectangular plastic protective sheet with a slit in the middle, and the back of the patch is backed by a transparent rectangular plastic paper.

### Indication

Prevention of nausea and vomiting in patients receiving moderately and/or highly emetogenic chemotherapy for 3-5 consecutive days.

### Strength

34.3mg /52cm<sup>2</sup> (drug release amount: 3.1 mg /24 h)

### Dosage and administration

This product should be applied to clean, dry, intact, and healthy outer skin of the upper arm. It should not be applied to red, irritated, or damaged skin. Each patch is packaged in a pouch and should be applied directly after the pouch is opened. Do not cut the patch into small pieces.

Adults: Apply a single patch on the outside of the upper arm at least 24 hours before chemotherapy. The patch can be applied up to 48 hours before chemotherapy. Remove the patch at least 24 hours after chemotherapy is completed. The patch can be used for up to 7 days, depending on the duration of the chemotherapy regimen.
