Generic name: Trazodone Hydrochloride Sustained-release Tablets

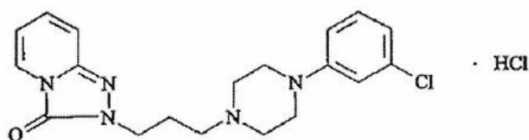

Ingredient

The active ingredient of the product is trazodone hydrochloride.

Chemical name: 2-{3-[4-(3-chlorophenyl)-1-piperazinyl]propyl}-1,2,4-triazolo[4,3- α]pyridine-3-(2H)-one hydrochloride

Excipients: Sucrose, Povidone, Carnaubic Acid, Magnesium Stearate

Description

This product is a long white to yellowish white tablet with two notches on each side.

Indication

For depression with or without anxiety.

Strength

(1)75mg; (2)150mg

Dosage and administration

This product is for adult use only.

Treatment should be started at night and the daily dose should be gradually increased. The medication cycle

should be at least one month.

Postprandial administration can reduce adverse effects (increase reabsorption and decrease peak plasma concentration).

This scored tablet can be divided into three parts to allow for escalating doses based on the patient's disease severity, weight, age and general condition.

Adults:

Take 75-150mg once every night before going to bed.

The maximum daily dose can be increased to 450 mg in two divided doses.

The daily doses of hospitalized patients (i.e., those with more severe depression) may be as high as but not more than 600 mg in divided doses.

Elderly patients:

For elderly or debilitated patients, the recommended initial dose should be reduced to 100 mg daily in divided doses or as a single dose at night. The dose can be gradually increased under supervision based on tolerance and efficacy. In general, a single dose for these patients should not exceed 100 mg. The daily dose should generally not exceed 300 mg.

Children:

Due to lack of safety data, this product should not be used by children and adolescents under the age of 18.
